In August 2016, Outdoor Youth Connections provided a grant for \$2,000 to Sound Salmon Solutions. The money will be used to support their Watershed Detectives program in 2016 and 2017.

Sound Salmon Solutions (SSS) is a 501c3 nonprofit organization that serves as the Regional Fisheries Enhancement Group for the Stillaguamish, Snohomish, and Island County watersheds in Washington State. SSS has a 25+ year history of engaging community members and youth in hands-on science lessons and grassroots habitat restoration.

The Watershed Detectives program is primarily aimed at 4th to 5th grade students. Close to four elementary classes will get a hands-on outdoor experiential education lesson and participate in a planting field trip at an active habitat restoration site near their school's watershed.

Students who participate in the Watershed Detectives Program will:

- Learn to appreciate and enjoy the great outdoors
- Improve scientific inquiry skills (NGSS standard: 5-ESS3-1)
- Learn three specific, personal actions they can take to improve water quality
 1. Pick up pet waste
 - 2. Wash car at an established car wash, or on lawn
 - 3. Use less/no fertilizers on lawns and in gardens
- Be aware that storm drains discharge water directly to streams, rivers, lakes and the Puget Sound without any treatment.
- Have the opportunity to actively engage in restoration, and to improve water quality, habitat and biodiversity, by planting native trees and shrubs in their local communities.
