Shoreline Exploration Program

OYC partnered with Snohomish County Juvenile Correction's Snohomish Teen Evening Program (STEP) and created the Shoreline Exploration Program.



The three-hour program provides youth with space to explore the Salish Sea shoreline, learn beach etiquette, ask questions, and learn about the various career opportunities related to shorelines.

The Shoreline Exploration Program is provided twice a month primarily from spring to early fall, with a few winter opportunities. Many youth in Snohomish County have never been to the beach despite living within a few

miles of the shoreline. We provide an opportunity for youth to connect with the beach and learn its value to our Salish culture.
